



PASCAL Expands Promise Ring Assortment With Seven New Couple Sets

Los Angeles, CA - September 17, 2026 -

PASCAL has expanded its online promise-ring assortment with seven coordinated ring sets published on April 22, 2026. The additions bring the brand's PASCAL couple promise rings selection to 15 live sets, priced from \$315 to \$560 at the time of publication. Each listing contains two rings designed as a pair rather than one ring offered in two sizes.

The new Ice Cube Diamond Couple Rings are listed at \$315 and place one central diamond in each band, pairing a wider ring with a narrower band in 18K gold vermeil over sterling silver. PASCAL describes its gold vermeil as an 18K gold layer over a sterling-silver base, a construction used across all seven April additions. Layered Cube Diamond Couple Rings, listed at \$560, use flat geometric faces and stepped profiles to distinguish the two coordinated forms.

The Soccer Openwork Diamond Couple Rings are also listed at \$560. Their openwork settings translate the paneled geometry of a soccer ball into precious-metal forms set with black and white lab-grown diamonds.

Freshman Gemstone Couple Rings, listed at \$425, use baguette-cut lab-grown gemstones held in channel settings across two differently proportioned bands.

Aeternum Cross Diamond Couple Rings are listed at \$550 and use raised cross motifs with lab-grown diamond accents. Daisy Bloom Diamond Couple Rings, listed at \$530, combine sculpted daisy reliefs with white lab-grown diamonds. Faceted Diamond Couple Rings, listed at \$400, pair two octagonal bands: one is set with six lab-grown diamonds, while the other uses a single 2 mm lab-grown diamond.

The broader PASCAL promise rings assortment contained 84 live listings when reviewed on September 15, 2026, with displayed prices ranging from \$102 to \$850. The group covers bands, signet rings, dome rings, colored-stone rings, diamond rings, and coordinated sets. Current examples include the \$155 Daisy Bloom Promise Ring with a white diamond, the \$390 Cluster Marquise Diamond Ring, and the \$850 Lucky Clover Promise Ring with green diamond pavé.

The dedicated PASCAL men's promise ring selection contained 54 live listings priced from \$102 to \$560 on the same date. Materials represented in the selection include 18K gold vermeil over sterling silver and black titanium, while stone treatments include white diamonds, black diamonds, colored diamonds, and lab-grown gemstones. Signet, band, eternity, and paired-ring structures are represented alongside narrower profiles.

Some rings appear in more than one online grouping, so the figures are section-level listing counts rather than a combined total of unique designs. Prices are the amounts shown on September 15, 2026 and may change after publication. The counts and ranges are included to define the scale of the expansion without treating overlapping listings as separate launches.

PASCAL organizes portions of its colored-stone assortment under the themes love, hope, power, luck, purity, and freedom. These associations belong to PASCAL's own design and merchandising framework; they are not presented as universal meanings assigned to gemstone colors. Individual settings, stone cuts, metal choices, and listed specifications remain the factual basis for distinguishing one ring from another.

PASCAL's Lab-Grown Diamonds Guide states that the company uses chemical vapor deposition, or CVD, to grow diamonds in a controlled laboratory environment rather than extract them through mining. The guide describes CVD as a process in which carbon is deposited onto a diamond seed before the resulting crystal is cut and polished. This production statement replaces the earlier release's broad sourcing language with a named method that readers can verify in PASCAL's published diamond education materials.

PASCAL's IGI certification information states that its lab-grown diamonds are independently examined and certified by the International Gemological Institute. According to PASCAL, the grading reports identify laboratory-grown origin and record cut, color, clarity, and carat weight. The certification language is attributed

to PASCAL and IGI documentation instead of being presented as an unsupported environmental or ethical guarantee.

The seven April additions extend the existing couple-ring selection through distinct construction details rather than a single repeated design. Central stones, openwork panels, channel-set baguettes, relief motifs, octagonal bands, and coordinated proportions give each set an identifiable specification. All current quantities and prices in this release reflect the PASCAL online store as reviewed on September 15, 2026.
