



Wedding Band Packages Expand Options for Reception Entertainment

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Planning live music for a wedding reception involves more than selecting a group of musicians. Venue requirements, equipment, event timing, announcements, and transitions can all affect how entertainment fits into the evening. Lost Wax Band addresses those considerations through a range of wedding band packages that combine different ensemble sizes with production and event support, giving couples several formats to consider when planning a reception.

The available packages range from a five-piece live band to a 10-piece ensemble with a full horn section, and include a hybrid option that combines live musicians with a DJ. Across its offerings, Lost Wax Band provides services including full backline, sound engineering, setup and teardown, song list development, sound production, live music emcee duties, and timeline creation. The approach places the musical performance alongside the practical production work required for a wedding reception.

The Signature 5-Piece Band provides the most compact of the featured full-band configurations. The lineup includes drums, guitar, bass, and two lead vocalists. Its repertoire is built around mashups and continuous transitions between songs, creating a format suited to receptions where dancing is a central part of the

evening. The package can also incorporate the production and coordination services needed to support the performance.

For couples seeking a larger ensemble, the 8-piece band adds a keyboard, saxophone, and a third lead vocalist to the drums, guitar, and bass. The additional musicians expand the band's instrumentation while maintaining a conventional live-performance format. The lineup can accommodate receptions that call for a broader musical arrangement without moving to the largest ensemble.

The 10-piece band adds another level of instrumentation through a three-piece horn section. Along with drums, guitar, bass, keyboard, and three lead vocalists, the expanded lineup provides a larger live ensemble for weddings where the entertainment plan calls for additional musicians on stage. The package also incorporates production support as part of the broader wedding entertainment service.

Another option, The Collective, combines a DJ with live musicians. The lineup includes a DJ, drums, guitar, violin, a three-piece horn section, and a lead vocalist. The hybrid format gives event planners a way to incorporate both DJ programming and live performance into the reception rather than selecting only one entertainment format.

The range of wedding band packages also reflects the logistical differences between wedding receptions. A venue's available space, stage configuration, event timeline, guest count, and desired musical format can all influence which ensemble is appropriate. Production services such as sound engineering, backline equipment, setup and teardown, and timeline creation can address operational details that otherwise require coordination among multiple vendors.

Live music emcee duties are another part of the service offering, helping connect musical performances with scheduled reception events such as introductions, dinner, speeches, and dancing. Song list planning and sound production further connect entertainment to the event's structure. These services allow the performance and production requirements to be considered together during the planning process.

For larger celebrations, Lost Wax Band also offers larger-scale wedding entertainment configurations with expanded ensembles and production services for black-tie weddings and marquee celebrations.
