replacement is appropriate. Replacement projects can involve equipment such as chillers, rooftop units, air handling units, pumps, boilers, and other mechanical components. The company also provides commercial building automation services for facilities that use controls to manage mechanical equipment and operating conditions.

Preventative maintenance remains an important part of the company's work because commercial HVAC equipment does not operate in isolation. Air handling units, chillers, cooling towers, rooftop units, pumps, exhaust fans, and related systems can require ongoing attention as operating demands change. Gray Mechanical provides planned HVAC and plumbing maintenance for equipment of different sizes and across several commercial sectors.

The company also maintains a safety program tied to employee training, site assessments, job-specific procedures, equipment training, daily safety checks, third-party audits, and continuing education. Gray Mechanical identifies itself as an OSHA-certified mechanical contractor, and its published safety information reports a current experience modification rate of 0.66, along with a DART rate and injury and illness incident rate of 0.00. Those figures are presented by the company as part of its ongoing safety program rather than as a measure of HVAC performance.

Its regulatory credentials include HVAC contractor license TACLA000045915C, regulated by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation, and plumbing license MPL38947, regulated by the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners. These credentials provide a specific regulatory framework for the company's HVAC and plumbing operations in Texas.

For commercial property teams evaluating commercial HVAC services in Houston, TX, Gray Mechanical offers support across the life of a mechanical system, from conceptual estimating and design-build work to installation, retrofit, maintenance, inspection, testing, and emergency service. The company serves the Greater Houston area and also operates in the Austin and San Antonio markets.

The company's work spans projects where mechanical systems must align with the needs of occupied buildings and specialized facilities. Its website identifies healthcare, laboratories, education, commercial offices, hospitality, and data centers among the industries served.
