The conference is designed to cater to a diverse audience of professionals, including surgeons, nurses, physician assistants, aestheticians, and industry experts, following the newly established AlliedPro branch of The Aesthetic Society. Not only does the schedule include many courses on plastic surgery topics, but nurse and physician assistant injectors—as well as those in non-physician roles in aesthetic practices—will have educational programming opportunities. These include workshops for Patient Care Coordinators and practice marketing professionals, as well as injectables training sessions open to nurses, physician assistants, and physicians.
