"We see significant improvements in dogs' social skills and overall temperament when they participate in structured play groups with appropriate supervision and guidance."

The facility serves pet owners from Pierce City, Purdy, Cassville, Mt Vernon, and Aurora, providing a central location for residents throughout the region to access professional pet care services. The daycare program operates alongside the hospital's comprehensive veterinary services, allowing staff to monitor participants' health while providing enrichment activities.

Daycare services at Monett Veterinary Hospital include supervised group play sessions, individual attention for dogs requiring special care, regular exercise periods, and rest breaks throughout the day. Staff members evaluate each dog's temperament and energy level to ensure appropriate group placement, maintaining safety while encouraging positive social interactions.

The Monett Vet Dog Boarding facility complements the daycare program by offering extended care options for pet owners traveling or facing emergency situations. The boarding services include climate-controlled indoor spaces, customized feeding schedules, medication administration when needed, and daily health observations by veterinary professionals.

Monett Veterinary Hospital received the AAHA Commitment to Excellence Award in 2007 and continues to maintain accreditation standards that reflect best practices in veterinary medicine and pet care services. The facility's evolution from a single-veterinarian practice established by Dr. C.J. McCormick in 1953 to a comprehensive animal care center demonstrates its commitment to meeting changing community needs.

The hospital's range of services extends beyond daycare and boarding to include routine and specialized surgery, radiology, internal medicine, preventive care programs, grooming, and an in-house laboratory. This integrated approach allows pet owners to access multiple services at a single location while ensuring continuity of care for their animals.
