Initial appointments involve a one-on-one consultation with a doctor to discuss the incident and health goals. This is followed by a complete spinal examination that includes motion and static palpation, range of motion assessment, digital posture analysis, orthopedic and neurological testing, and digital motion X-rays. These real-time imaging tools allow observation of joint function and identification of issues not visible in standard static images.

Chiropractic adjustments in Little Rock at Restoration Health Chiropractic incorporate Chiropractic Biophysics techniques.
