Rollers and hinges require particular attention during summer months. The combination of heat, dust, and frequent use can cause lubrication to break down faster than during cooler seasons. Metal components expand and contract with temperature fluctuations, potentially loosening bolts and brackets that secure the door system.

Garage door springs face additional stress during summer as doors open and close more frequently. A typical residential torsion spring is rated for approximately 10,000 cycles, and increased summer usage can significantly reduce this lifespan. Regular inspection helps identify early signs of spring fatigue before complete failure occurs.

Modern garage door openers contain sensitive electronics that can struggle in extreme heat. Tennessee's humid summers can cause condensation inside opener units, while direct sunlight on metal doors can create temperatures exceeding manufacturer specifications. Opener delays or inconsistent operation often indicate heat-related stress on motor components.

Safety sensors require special attention during summer when lawn care activities increase. Grass clippings, dust, and accidental contact from garden tools can knock sensors out of alignment or coat lenses with debris. Regular cleaning and alignment checks ensure these critical safety features function properly.
