Professional technicians recommend homeowners perform visual inspections monthly, looking for signs of wear such as fraying cables, rust on springs, or doors that appear uneven when closed. Unusual sounds during operation, including grinding, squeaking, or popping noises, often indicate components that need attention. Safety features should be tested regularly by placing an object in the door's path to ensure the auto-reverse function activates properly.

Beyond safety concerns, properly maintained garage doors contribute to home energy efficiency during summer months. Doors with worn weather seals or damaged panels can allow hot air to enter garages, increasing cooling costs for attached living spaces. Regular maintenance helps ensure doors seal properly, maintaining comfortable temperatures and reducing energy consumption.
