



All Pro Newton Deck Builders Expands Service Area to Cambridge, MA

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NEWTON, MA - July 28, 2026 -

All Pro Newton Deck Builders has extended its deck building and repair services to Cambridge, Massachusetts, adding the city to a service area that already covers much of the greater Boston region. The move extends the contractor's deck construction and repair operations into an established residential section north of the Charles River.

Cambridge is home to more than 118,000 residents within roughly six square miles, making it one of the more densely populated cities in Massachusetts. Much of the city's housing predates 2000, with only about 14 percent of units built since then, leaving a large base of older homes where decks, porches, and outdoor structures often require repair, replacement, or first-time construction. The city sits within the Boston-Cambridge-Newton metropolitan area, the same region the company has served from its Newton base. That combination of established properties and limited new building shapes the kind of work the expansion is meant to address.

Decks on older properties tend to face wear from repeated freeze-and-thaw cycles, moisture, and aging fasteners and framing, which can make repair or full replacement necessary over time. Restoration work on

these structures often involves replacing deck boards, reinforcing or rebuilding support framing, and updating railings to current code. New England's climate, with cold winters and humid summers, places added stress on outdoor wood and composite surfaces across the region.

The expansion responds to steady demand for outdoor living space across eastern Massachusetts, according to company leadership. "Cambridge has a dense mix of older homes where deck repair and replacement are common needs, and the expansion places a dedicated crew closer to those projects," said John Greene, owner of All Pro Newton Deck Builders. The closer coverage is intended to shorten scheduling and response times for Cambridge clients.

Beyond new deck construction, the work available in Cambridge covers deck repair and restoration, porch design and installation, patios and hardscapes, shade structures such as pergolas, and pool decks. The same services are offered by Newton Deck Builders across neighboring communities, among them Somerville, Watertown, Arlington, and Belmont, several of which share a border with Cambridge. Extending the footprint into Cambridge connects a contiguous block of territory north and west of Boston.

Deck construction in Massachusetts is regulated under the state building code, which sets requirements for structural support, railings, and permitting on residential projects. Work in a built-up city such as Cambridge can involve compact lots, shared property lines, and existing structures, conditions the company says factor into design and scheduling for the area. The expansion adds Cambridge to a roster of more than a dozen communities the contractor lists within its service region.

Demand for deck building across the Northeast typically rises ahead of the warmer months, when outdoor entertaining and yard use increase. Scheduling for spring and summer projects often begins earlier in the year, and proximity to a job site can affect how quickly a contractor is able to start. The company has pointed to that timing as one reason for positioning crews nearer to Cambridge ahead of the active building season.

According to the company, projects are staffed with local craftsmen familiar with New England building styles and the way decks and porches relate to a home's existing structure and lot. In a dense city, that can mean designing within tight setbacks, matching a deck to the scale of nearby homes, and accounting for shared property lines. Those constraints factor into the company's planning for projects in the area.

Greene said the decision reflects a longer pattern of growth around Newton and the surrounding suburbs. "Demand for decks and porches has held steady as homeowners invest in outdoor space, and Cambridge was a natural next step given the work already underway nearby," Greene said. The company plans to handle Cambridge projects with the same local crews used in adjacent towns.
