



All Pro Newton Deck Builders Expands Service Area to Somerville

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All Pro Newton Deck Builders has extended its deck design, construction, and repair services to Somerville, Massachusetts, giving homeowners in the city direct access to a contractor that previously concentrated on the greater Newton region. The expansion took effect this year and applies to residential deck projects throughout the community.

Somerville holds roughly 81,000 residents within about four square miles, a population density well above state and national averages. That density leaves many homeowners working with compact lots and limited yard space, conditions that raise the importance of carefully planned outdoor structures. The move into the market responds to demand from property owners seeking usable exterior living areas without enlarging a home's footprint.

The service extension covers new deck construction, replacement of aging or unsafe structures, and repair of existing decks. Projects include pressure-treated lumber, composite decking, and hardwood, along with railings, stairs, and multi-level layouts suited to the sloped or irregular lots common in older neighborhoods. Work is coordinated with the local permitting and building-code requirements that govern residential deck

construction across Massachusetts.

Deck construction in dense settings often involves tighter site access, shared property lines, and stricter setback rules than suburban projects. The Massachusetts building code requires guardrails on decks raised above a set height and specifies fastening and footing standards intended to prevent structural failure. Addressing those factors early in the design process helps homeowners clear municipal review with fewer revisions.

"The expansion into Somerville reflects steady interest from homeowners who want durable outdoor space that fits smaller city lots," said John Greene, owner of All Pro Newton Deck Builders. Greene noted that the rollout was structured to keep design consultations and project timelines consistent with the standards applied across surrounding communities.

Local review for a residential deck typically includes submission of a site plan, structural details, and property setbacks to the municipal building department, followed by inspections at set stages of construction. Coordinating those steps with a homeowner's timeline reduces the risk of stop-work delays. The company handles permit filing and inspection scheduling as part of standard project management.

Composite decking has accounted for a growing share of residential installations nationally in recent years, a shift driven largely by lower long-term maintenance compared with natural wood. Homeowners in the area frequently weigh those material options against budget and appearance during the planning stage. Greene said material selection and permitting guidance form a substantial part of early conversations with clients.

Outdoor living space has drawn increased attention from homeowners since remote and hybrid work expanded the hours many people spend at home. Real estate analyses have often linked well-built decks to added usable square footage and improved resale appeal, though returns vary by market and material. In compact communities, a deck can function as a primary outdoor room rather than a supplement to a large yard.

The company built its operations around the neighboring Newton area before extending crews eastward into Somerville. Contiguous growth of that kind allows established scheduling, supplier relationships, and inspection routines to carry over to a new service zone. The approach is intended to shorten the ramp-up period that can accompany entry into an unfamiliar municipal market.

Seasonal conditions shape project timing across New England, where frost and snow limit outdoor construction for portions of the year. Contractors frequently concentrate installation work during warmer months and use the off-season for design, estimates, and permit preparation. Planning ahead of peak demand can help homeowners secure preferred build dates.

The Somerville service area connects to existing coverage across Newton and nearby Middlesex County communities, allowing crews to reach projects without extended travel. That geographic continuity supports scheduling as well as follow-up for warranty and repair requests. Residents can review project types and service details before requesting an on-site consultation.
